It's called ShopWithScrip or *scrip*—the fundraising program that works while you shop. It allows families to raise money for Franklin Fine Arts Center by using gift cards to pay for everyday purchases—gift cards from national and local retailers—the exact same gift cards you'd buy at the store.

The beauty of scrip is that you put many of your regular shopping dollars to work—earning money for our school—without spending a single additional penny! Just spend your regular shopping dollars with scrip at the stores that participate in the scrip program. And scrip can be used for many household purchases including food, clothing, entertainment, gasoline—even dining out!

You're probably asking yourself how these stores help us raise money? It's simple! Our scrip participating retailers agree to sell gift cards to Franklin at a discount. Member families like yours buy the gift cards for full face value, redeem them for full face value, and Franklin keeps the difference! The most exciting part, our school gets a regular source of revenue that involves no selling!

Two ways to place a scrip order:

OPTION 1 – ORDER ONLINE AT SHOPWITHSCRIP.COM

- Create an account at www.ShopWithScrip.com (Use the green Family Sign Up box!)
- Enter FFAC enrollment code: 45F9AA6931662
- Print out order confirmation and return it to the school office
- Include cash or a check made payable to: **Friends of Franklin**

OPTION 2 – ORDER AT SCHOOL

- Include cash or check made payable to: **Friends of Franklin**
